The Foodlink Career Fellowship is an intensive, yearlong culinary program that includes both classroom and hands-on training within Foodlink's state-of-theart Community Kitchen. Fellows play an integral role in preparing thousands of healthy meals daily for Rochester children, all while increasing the core competencies needed for largescale food production.

The final months of the program are spent at an externship with a regional employer.

The Fellowship is an official New York State Registered Apprenticeship training program — the first such cook apprenticeship in the state.
